Dear Chairman Saccardi:

I am writing on behalf of the City of Louisville, to express the City's opposition to the pending application by Pinnacle Towers, Inc. to construct three broadcast towers on top of Eldorado Mountain.

The proposed towers at over 400 feet will be highly visible from over numerous City residences, City open space and US 36. The negative impacts to surrounding residential and recreational lands; night lighting and visibility to homes, parks and open space are substantial. The proposal makes no considerations for residents of the surrounding area, and downplays the visual impacts of the proposed towers. Again, Louisville strongly urges your opposition.

Additionally, there are existing sites, which provide comparable signal coverage without some of the adverse consequences present at the Eldorado site. I would urge the Commission to investigate these alternatives thoroughly.
